Instructors: **Sgt. Frank Hartig:** Has been with the Benicia Police Department for 22 years. He has previously worked K-9, SWAT, Narcotics and has supervised a Narcotics Team. Sgt. Hartig has participated in numerous narcotic operations/investigations from both a patrol and investigative standpoint. Sgt. Hartig is a Drug Abuse Recognition expert. Frank is currently assigned to Traffic riding Motors.

Inspector Steve Lynn: Has been a police officer since 1989. He is currently the Senior Inspector assigned to the Major Gang/Narcotics Prosecution Unit for Contra Costa County. Steve has worked solely in the area of narcotic and gang enforcement for the past 10 years, spending 6 years with WESTNET in Contra Costa County. He has worked extensively as an undercover agent and has conducted over 200 undercover purchases. He has testified in State and Federal court as an expert in all aspects of narcotic investigations. Insp. Lynn is the 2009 Region One Alfred E. Stewart Award Winner.

Description: This class will show the student how drug dealers weigh, package and distribute their drugs. There will be a large display of Controlled Substances, paraphernalia, and other items used by drug dealers and users. The student will weigh, package, and be shown how drug users ingest controlled substances. This is an excellent class for all aspects of Law Enforcement to include patrol, investigations and detention. This class is designed to educate the Officer/Deputy on how to recognize controlled substances and drug paraphernalia. Instructional topics include:

- Different types of Controlled Substances
- Elements of a possession for sales case
- Types of paraphernalia used by controlled substances abusers
- How different Controlled Substances are weighed and packaged for sale
- Current drug trends and prices
